AWARDS

Award of Merit

The OGC offers five types of Awards of Merit. To qualify the animal must be owned by an OGC member and can be either Purebred, American, or a Grade. Along with the application, a copy of the animal's registration papers must be sent in. The applications for the awards are to be sent in as soon as possible for recognition for the previous year.

The Award of Merit for Type is similar to the All American competition in other breed clubs. Awards are given for three different classes, doelings (under two years of age), milkers, and bucks. Photos are to be submitted with the application.

The Award of Merit for Production are for does who are on an ADGA recognized milk test or completed a One Day Milk test. The doe's milk record for the previous year's lactation must be sent in with the application.

The Award of Merit for Linear is for the Linear Appraisal of an animal who scored a 90 or above. A copy of the Linear Appraisal score sheet is to be sent in with the application. The other names on the sheet are to be blocked out that are not being recognized.

The Award of Merit for Performance is the award of championship for ADGA/AGS during the current year. A copy of the letter of recognition or copy of the updated papers are to be sent in with the application.

Supreme Award of Merit is the recognition of an animal that has been recognized for three different types of awards.

SUPPORTED ENTRY

Supported Entry and Specialty Shows

Members please let your local clubs know that the OGS is now accepting applications for Supported entry and Specialty Shows. The difference between the two are that Supported Entries are where a breed is sponsored to have additional classes during an all breed ADGA sanctioned show. Specialty shows are where a breed is sanctioned separately from other regularly sanctioned shows.

The requirements for application approval, the host show must have had a minimum Oberhasli numbers for official sanctuary in at least one of the previous two years shows. The show must sanction Oberhasli as a separate breed; the Senior Does and Junior Does separately; and Bucks are optional. Also, the host show must offer a Champion Challenge class and a minimum of two group classes for the Senior and Junior Does.
