Ingredients:

- Raw goat milk
- Kefir Grains (live)
- A glass jar
- A plastic strainer (metal will kill the probiotics)
- A dish towel or coffee filter
- A rubber band
- A bamboo knife or spoon to transfer.
- Optional: crystals

Directions:

- Take your kefir grains and rinse them off in your plastic strainer with purified water.
- Add them to your glass jar. Pour cold, fresh, raw goat milk over them all the way to the top of the jar.
- Put a dish towel or coffee filter over the top, and then seal with a rubber band.
- Place this jar in a somewhat warm place overnight.
- Leave this to ferment for 24 hours.
